2025 SEASON

- The first step in the Automobile Club de l'Ouest competitions pyramid.
- The embodiment of the "**Spirit of Le Mans**" with a sport-prototype category (Ligier JS P4) and a GT category (Ligier JS2 R).
- A championship that promotes its drivers with three classifications per category: overall, AM, PRO-AM.
- Meetings that are condensed over two days (Friday/Saturday) during the weekends of the Michelin Le Mans Cup and the European Le Mans Series, with 3 hours 40 minutes of racing on the most beautiful F1 circuits.*
- The opportunity to discover the Le Mans 24 Hours circuit with an exceptional race on Test Day alongside the Hypercars, LMGT3s and LMP2s.
- A launch pad for drivers wishing to progress in endurance thanks in particular to a unique prize system: more than € 250,000 in prize money to enable the champion(s) of the twocategories to continue their ascent up the ACO pyramid.

A FIVE STAR CALENDAR

- 6 meetings on the best European tracks with a support race during the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

- 2 x 40-minute free practice sessions,
- 2 x 15-minute qualifying sessions,
- -2 x 1-hour races.
- Meeting condensed on 2 days to allow drivers to reconcile their passion, professional and personal lives:
- The free practice sessions and qualifying take place on Friday.
- The races take place on Saturday (one in the morning and one in the afternoon).



AN EXCEPTIONAL ROUND ON THE 24 HOURS OF LE MANS TRACK

Since 2022, the Ligier European Series has been offering drivers and teams the unique opportunity to race on the Le Mans 24 Hours circuit.

This exceptional round will take place in 2025 on Test Day as in the previous years, with a specific format.

With almost forty cars taking part in its first edition, the "Le Mans Heat" is the highlight of each season. Drivers and teams from all over the world join the series for this extraordinary race.












TWO CATEGORIES

The sport-prototype category with the Ligier JS P4s and the GT category with the Ligier JS2 Rs.

DRIVING CREWS

- A maximum of two drivers are authorised per car.
- The eligible drivers are Bronze, Silver or Gold.
- The combination of drivers allowed are: Silver, Silver-Silver, Silver-Bronze, Gold-Bronze, Bronze-Bronze, Bronze.

PRO-AM AND AM CLASSES

With a growing field, the series attracts a wide variety of drivers and crews from different sporting horizons and from the four corners of the world.

Two specific classes exist in each category of the championship:

- A PRO-AM classification for Gold-Bronze and Silver-Bronze crews;
- An AM classification for Bronze only and Bronze-Bronze duos.

Drivers eligible for these two classifications also compete in the general classification of both categories.

Silver solo drivers and Silver-Silver crews compete for the overall titles.







BOOST YOUR ENDURANCE CAREER

As the first step in the ACO competition pyramid, the Ligier European Series is a real platform for all drivers wishing to progress in endurance racing:

- Discover endurance racing and the sporting rules of ACO competitions.
- Learn how to deal with the traffic (GT vs.sport prototype) and the Michelin Le Mans Cup and European Le Mans Series circuits.
- Race alongside the teams and drivers of the higher categories (LMP3, LMP2, GT3) and get visibility thanks to the live broadcasts of the races throughout the paddock.
- Benefit from the media exposure of the ACO championships.
- Try to win the prizes reserved for the champions in each category.

€ 250.000 OF PRIZE MONEY AT STAKE EACH SEASON

Since 2022, more than € 250,000 in prize money are at stake each season in the general overall classifications of the Ligier JS P4 and Ligier JS2 R categories.

- The champion(s) of the Ligier JS P4 sport-prototype category will receive a **prize money equivalent to € 150,000** to be used exclusively the year after to enter the Michelin Le Mans Cup at the controls of a Ligier JS P325 with a team selected by Ligier Automotive.
- On the GT side, the champion(s) will receive a **prize** money equivalent to € 100,000 to compete exclusively in the Ligier European Series the following year in a Ligier JS P4 with a team selected by the constructor.









A TALENT INCUBATOR

Gillian Henrion, from Ligier European Series to WEC FIA Rookie Test, an outstanding journey up the endurance pyramid.

Having made it as far as Formula 3, the French driver had a one-year break in 2021 before returning to competition. He chose the Ligier European Series and the Ligier JS P4 to discover endurance racing and ACO competitions. In 2022, he won 11 of the 12 races disputed and became **JS P4 Champion** with Team Virage.

Thanks to the € 150,000 prize fund, he continued his ascent and raced in the Michelin Le Mans Cup in 2023 at the wheel of a Ligier JS P320, winning the LMP3 title in the Michelin Le Mans Cup with Team Virage and Julien Gerbi.

In 2024, Gillian Henrion continued his progress in the European Le Mans Series, finishing **LMP3 Vice-Champion** at the wheel of Team Virage's Ligier JS P320.

His story didn't end there, however, as he was selected for the **FIA WEC Rookie Test**.











"To be crowned champion in a European series is something important. I really loved the Ligier JS P4 and the fact that it's a sport -prototype very close to the LMP3."

He finished 10th in LMP3 in the Michelin Le Mans Cup 2024.



Bernardo Pinheiro, 2023 JS P4 Runner-up with Team Virage

With his first experience in the Ligier European Series, Bernardo Pinheiro successfully tackled the ELMS with Team Virage. His team finished runner-up in the LMP3 class in 2024.



Julien Lemoine, 2023 JS2 R Champion with ANS Motorsport

"Before choosing a championship, I first of all chose a car: the JS2 R. It's the perfect car for learning the basics of driving."

He competed in the Michelin Le Mans Cup in an LMP3 in 2024.



Cédric Oltramare, 2021 and 2022 JS2 R driver with COOL Racing

After two seasons in a Ligier JS2 R in 2021 and 2022 and several podium finishes, Cédric Oltramare moved up to LMP3 in the Michelin Le Mans Cup in 2023. He finished fifth in the championship. In 2024, he in the ELMS and finished fourth in LMP3 with COOL Racing.



Sébastien Baud, 2020 JS2 R Champion

The first JS2 R champion in the history of the series in 2020, Sébastien Baud went on to compete in GT4 and then GT3. In 2024, at the age of 23, he raced for Corvette in LMGT3 in the World Endurance Championship.




